ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Special Education is a two-year AEC career program. The successful completion of this program allows students to acquire the skills that are necessary to exercise the profession of a Special Care Counselor or a Specialized Educator. Graduates will be able to work with people who have or may have different problems causing maladjustment to social inclusion, work with people with physical and psychological disabilities, behavior problems, disorders linked to mental and health-related disorders. Interventions are adapted to all age groups, whether they be targeted at children, teenagers, adults, or seniors.

The AEC program also satisfies the same skills and competencies targeted by the three-year DEC program in Special Care Counselling.

WHAT DO SPECIALIZED EDUCATORS DO?

The role of a specialized educator is to analyze and evaluate the problem of the person involved in the family and his or her community, to develop a suitable intervention plan, and make individual or group interventions. These activities are based on the situations of everyday life to improve communication and every dimension of the life of the person in difficulty (emotional, social, cognitive, psychomotor, morale, etc).

IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CSSDM

TAV College's Special Education program holds an exclusive partnership with le Centre de services scolaire de Montréal (CSSDM). Recruitment agents are present at TAV two (2) times per year to hire full-time employees as well as recruit students for their internship program.
